



JESUS WALKS... WITH YOU!

DIG DEEPER

It's awesome to have people who walk and do life with you. In a marriage, both walk together side-by-side. If you're still single, and not there yet, you have friends and loved ones who are always willing to walk by your side. In **Luke 24:13-31**, we find the story of two frustrated, confused, and even angry disciples walking together, when suddenly Jesus appears and joins them (without them recognizing Him). Sometimes in life, we can feel like these disciples, all alone and Jesus is nowhere to be found. This story teaches us the truth, that JESUS wants to draw near to us and longs to hear our frustrations. He longs to remind you and I that He continues to work in us amid the chaos and confusion.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. What is your level of awareness that Jesus is walking with you today?
- 2. Have you ever felt disappointed by the way something turned out?
- 3. Why do you think the two disciples didn't recognize it was Jesus walking with them?



"So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him.

- Luke 24:15-16 (NKJV)

SIMPLICITY

Just as Jesus waited for the two disciples to invite him into their home, Jesus also waits for you to invite him into your life. If we learn anything from this story, it's that "JESUS is working **IN YOU** through what is happening **TO YOU**." Although He cares a lot about what is happening to you right now, He is more interested in what is happening in you. HE is workin'! Remember **Romans 8:28**.

Invite the group to allow Jesus inside their hearts. Afterwards, minister peace, and challenge them to trust that God is using the process (situation) they are going through, to bring about His amazing works!
